## IAIS publish 2025 edition of Global Insurance Market Report (GIMAR)

### Latest developments

Today the IAIS has published the 2025 edition of the annual Global Insurance Market Report (GIMAR), which provides insights into this years' Global Monitoring Exercise (GME) of the IAIS.

The report highlights global macro financial developments and key sector-wide themes influencing insurers' risk profiles, business models and supervisory priorities.

- The report underscores the resilience of the global insurance sector, supported by strong solvency, liquidity and profitability, alongside a slight decline in aggregate systemic risk.
- It also delves into key sector-wide themes, including the rapid growth of investment in private credit, deepening geoeconomic fragmentation and the rising adoption of artificial intelligence, which are identified as supervisory priorities.
- Additionally, it highlights the need for enhanced supervisory focus on emerging risks, such as climate-related exposures and cyber risks, to support the continued stability of the global insurance sector.
